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Key Concepts

- AI can help you brainstorm ideas, organize thoughts, improve wording, create checklists, and compare options.
- AI should not replace your thinking. You still make the final decision and must understand your work.
- Never enter private personal information into AI tools. Do not create fake claims, fake reviews, or copy another business.
- Business ideas are stronger when they connect to your real interests, skills, resources, and people you like helping.
